Campers and tents may not be set until after noon on Sunday July 22nd. Campers must be in place by 6pm on Monday July 23rd. All Individuals must have a paid Fairgrounds Membership and site paid in full before camper is set up. Primitive/Non-Electric Camping is located along the east drive. Campers wanting electric will be parked along the fence north of the horse barn. Generators may be used at the fair but can only be run from 7am to 11pm. Quiet hours are from 11pm -7am. There will be no water hookups available for any camper.

A parent or guardian over age 21 must be present each night. They should be the person that fills out this form and is present on the fairgrounds from 11pm – 7am. Failure to comply will result in eviction from property and loss of spot for future years. No refunds. No pets allowed except service animals with papers. No bikes, pools, fire pits allowed. Any other recreational structures to be approved at the discretion of the fair board.

Only one vehicle with a vehicle pass may be parked next to or near your camper. Vehicles must be parked far enough off the road to allow both lanes of traffic to pass.

The Allen County Fairgrounds and Allen County 4-H Clubs are not responsible for any damage to campers, trailers or vehicles at any time. Owner assumes all responsibility, including if vehicle is not parked in proper locations.
